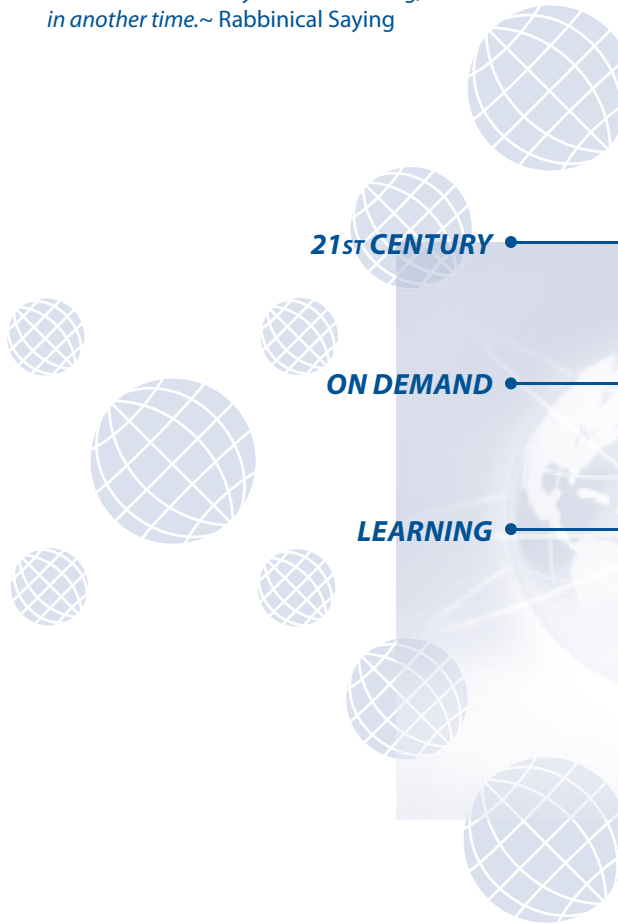

McKinney ISD offers students in grades 8-12 options for alternative learning settings through tuition based online coursework. Online coursework will be for acceleration only. Classes can be taken either during a student's zero period at any high school campus, or on the student's own time from home.

MISD has contracted with Apex Learning, an internet company who will provide the course content. MISD teachers will facilitate the classes.

Credit Reporting for Online Coursework:

Credit reporting for online courses will follow existing correspondence course policies. MISD students must be approved for online coursework through their campus counselor.

•Students currently enrolled in an MISD high school will be allowed to take no more than two online courses per semester and two per summer.

•Grades earned in online courses will not be used in computing class rankings.

•Students currently enrolled in an MISD school shall be able to earn a total of two credits or four semesters through online coursework.

Payment options

•Through personal check, cashier's check or money order made payable to McKinney ISD.

•Payment should be made during student's registration and returned to the campus registrar.

•Reimbursement guidelines:

Within 15 days of registration, students may cancel enrollment and receive a reimbursement. A fee of 50.00 will be retained for administrative expenses.

•Some courses may require the purchase of additional materials not included in the tuition fee.



Format

Students taking online courses will be required to attend one two hour session on campus for training on how to use the programs. Students have the option to take the course in a classroom setting during zero period or on their own from home. Students must complete an online course within the semester it was started. Seniors must submit grades for an online course at least 30 days prior to graduation.
