

Crowd Funding

Crowd funding is defined as fundraising through online websites such as Gofundme.com, Snapraise.com, etc. The services establish websites as requested for the McKinney ISD Organization/Club with an explanation of the need and proposed use of the donated funds. Individuals will direct their giving online to the service. The fundraising website will collect the funds, keep a percentage, and distribute the remainder to the McKinney ISD Organization/Club.

All funds must be for the benefit of McKinney ISD Student Organizations/Clubs only. No funds can go to any individual, third-party or directed outside McKinney ISD Organizations/Clubs.

McKinney ISD requires that such fundraising must comply with established procedures stated in the Student Activities Manual. In addition, disbursements from the funds must be requested in check form made to McKinney ISD. Funds may NOT be made to anything other than McKinney ISD. McKinney ISD will then deposit received funds into the appropriate McKinney ISD Organization/Club account.

All other fundraising must not reference McKinney ISD.

A district-wide charity (501C3) giving may be established by the Superintendent.
