

IMPACT OF THE 2016 BOND PROGRAM ON:

Dowell Middle School



On March 17, the McKinney ISD Board of Trustees approved a detailed list of projects to be included in a bond program that will go before voters on May 7.

The items approved by the board include major initiatives for technology, safety and security, fine arts, renovations and improvements across the district and a new districtwide stadium/event center.

Previous district bond initiatives have focused heavily on school construction and expansion projects. The 2016 bond program allows the board to address renovations and

program enhancements.

The proposed bond package will allow for a decrease in the tax rate by 4.5 cents (up from the previously estimated 2 cent decrease), which equates to a property tax decrease of approximately \$121 a year for an average residential home in MISD valued at \$271,150.

The 2016 bond program will allow for a decrease in the current tax rate by 4.5 cents.
