Enrollment Qualifications



- Child must be 3 or 4 years old on or before Sep 1.
- Must meet Federal income guidelines.

Head Start also accepts...

- Children with an identified disability.
- Children who are homeless.
- Foster children.



What Do I need to Bring?

- Child's official birth certificate.
- Child's up-to-date shot records.
- Medicaid or insurance card, if applicable.
- Current proof of residence within district's attendance boundaries.
- Proof of income: 1040 Tax transcripts, W-2s, pay stubs, self employment documentation: TANF, SSI, Social Security income, child support and any other public assistance.

Does Head Start Provide Transportation?

Bus transportation may be provided if the child is accepted into the Head Start program.
