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McKinney North High School is a 5A school located in McKinney, Texas, just 33 miles north of Dallas. MNHS opened its doors in August of 2000 and now has an enrollment of more than 2,000 students. MNHS is proud to host the District's Health Sciences program where students can earn state and/or national certifications in one of six medical fields. Students may also choose to enroll in our Aviation program and earn their pilot's license or participate in a wide variety of UIL sports and Fine Arts programs.


## Grade Scale:

MNHS awards grade points on a weighted $4 / 5 / 6$ scale and uses a 9-week grading system. Each semester of each course is worth 0.5 credits.
